- **2.2e** Conduct a curriculum audit of literacy instruction 4-12 and revise/create district writing expectations and curriculum.
- 2.2f Establish, implement and monitor writing expectations across all areas of study.
- **2.2g** Ensure all PreK-12 instructional staff participate in professional development around common writing expectations.
