


- Budget info
- Reviewed (FCSD Website) Budget Parameters within each of the 6 areas of the SCP
- Federal COVID Stimulus Funds- One time funds (14+ mil) expire 9/30/24
 - Approx 30 positions (2.5 mil)- AIS, TAs, Peaceful Schools, Restorative Practice Specialists, nurse, 6th grade counselor
 - Desks, technology equipment upgrades


a. Graduation Rate- 84.5%

- *ii.* Students who are dropping, were they present during COVID and do not want to return to in-person or were they lost since returning? Many were lost/not engaged the entire time. Some students who couldn't return to in-person were offered the Synergy program (CiTi program). Medical concerns
- **b.** Chronic absenteeism- Students with less than 91% attendance (42.5% of all GRB students are chronically absent.)

- Regents Exams WILL be administered in June and August. Feedback on ways to prepare our students?
 - Create a calendar of review sessions being offered
 - Flexible times to accommodate ALL students, including athletes and those involved in clubs
 - Offer snacks/dinner
 - Offer gym time/PE make-ups
 - Begin week of May 2nd
 - Provide virtual options
 - Are the Regents exams going to be averaged into a student's final grade?
 Yes, 20%.
 - If there is an exam where a majority of students don't do well, will it still be averaged in?
 - This will be looked at on a case-by-case basis.
 - Are there ways where a student can graduate without passing 5 Regents?
 - Yes, they have to pass 4 exams (1 in each core), and then students have what is called a "plus one" option. One pathway is CDOS that includes the WorkKeys Exam.
 - Multiple Pathways to Graduation
 - Can we offer test taking skills as a course? Teachers embed strategies into their review sessions and classes.

- Students need to learn how to study.
- Is there a list of websites/resources that students can access to assist with studying?
 - We created a site in the past and will update it.
 - Parents need this information.
- NYS is looking at graduation outcomes and the impact of Regents Exams.
 - Looking at changes beginning Spring 2024
