Purpose of and Charge to this BOE Advisory Committee

The committee will also assist in developing and implementing the methods by which we will gather input, including surveys and focus groups. In the spring of 2023, the committee will present up to three possible options to our Board of Education and our school community.

Charge: Generate three (3) recommendations for a new name/logo/branding for the Fulton City School District to the FCSD Board of Education for a May 2023 Board of Education meeting. Final determination and resolution by the FCSD Board of Education June 2023. Meeting Ground Rules
